All of the words above total 44 words. Which means there are 44 words you can teach through OG that follow rules the kids have learned AND they still count as high frequency words for the report card.

Trick Words

Words in red are words that must be memorized using multisensory activities (trace-copy-write) while saying the letters out loud and then the whole word. The words on the same line across can be taught at the same time/same week. The rest should be divided throughout the year, once ALL consonants and vowels are taught (letter name, formation, and sound.) Please do not teach more than 3 of these words in a week. Total red words - 31

By the time the kids know all the rules for green words and have learned to read AND spell the red words, you will have the 75 high frequency words needed for report cards.
